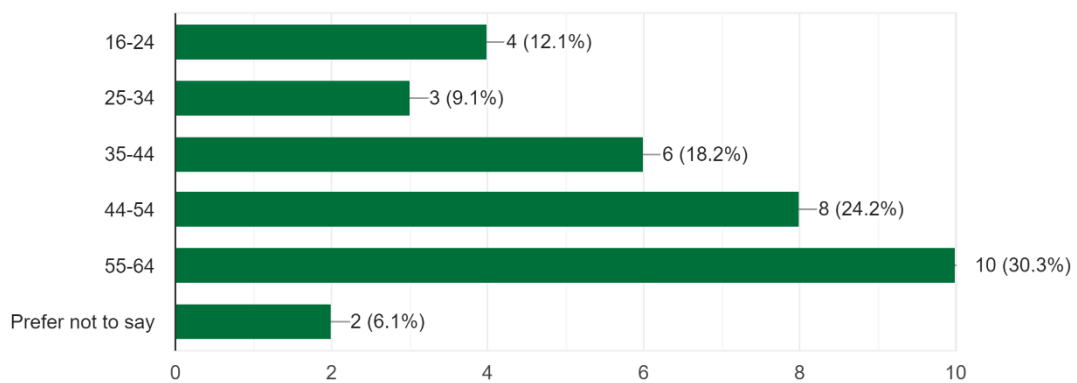

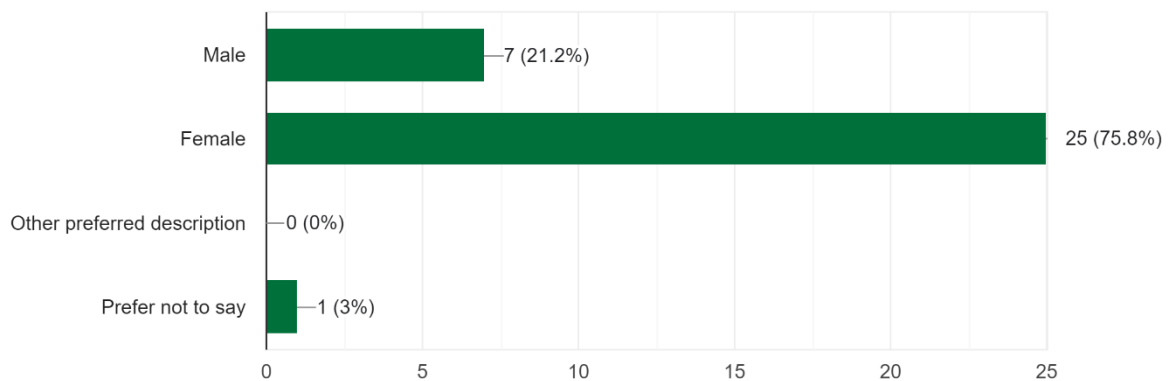
2. Which age category are you in?

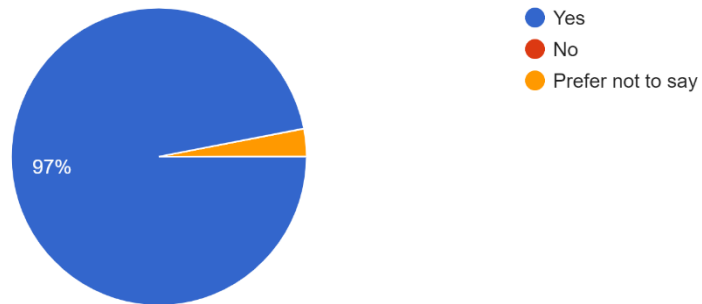
3. What is your sex?

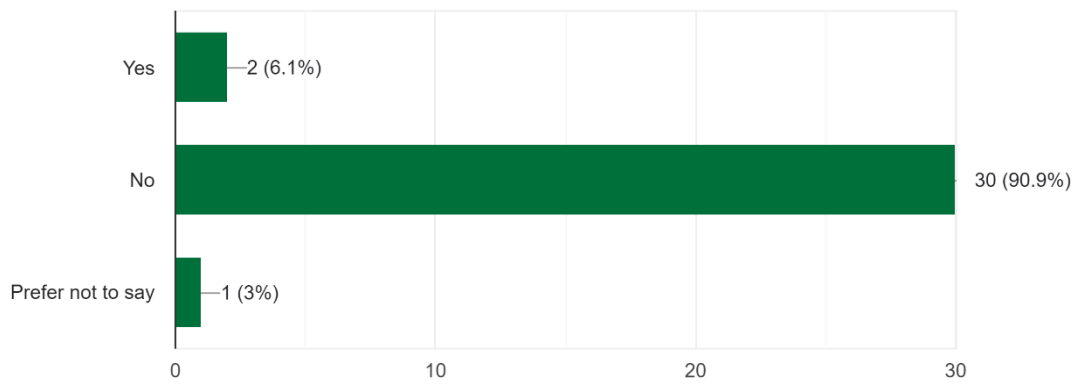
4. Is the gender you identify with the same as your sex registered at birth?

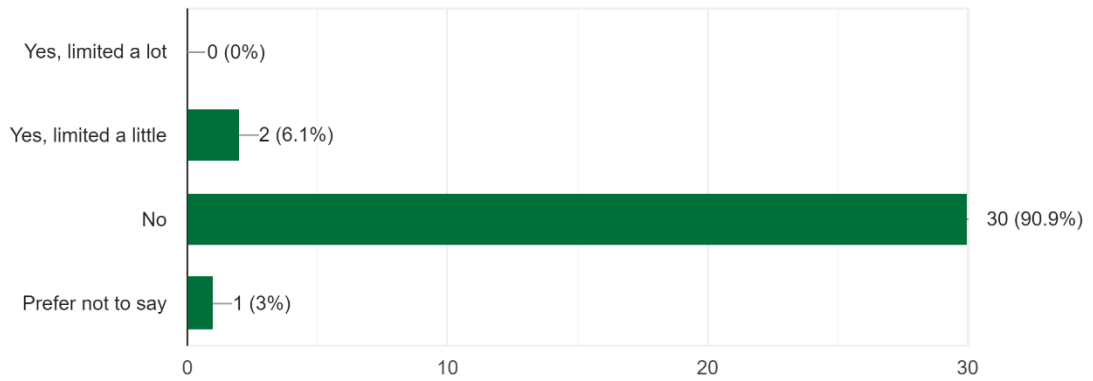

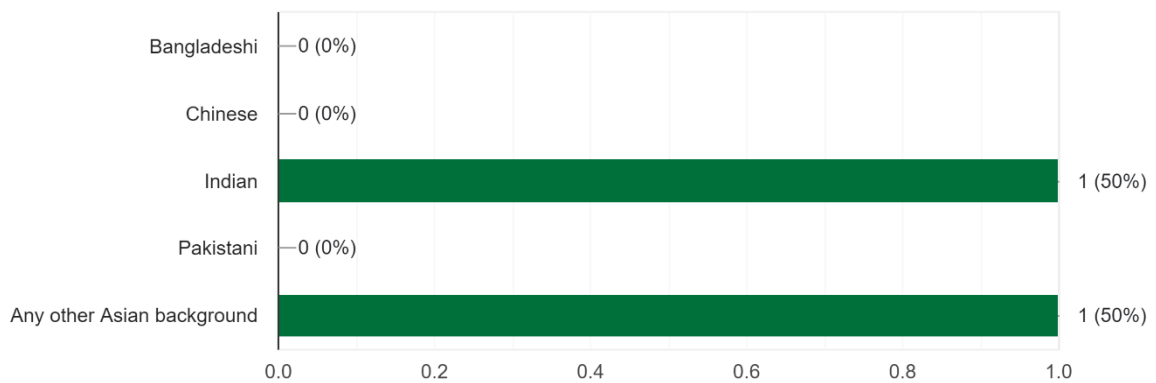

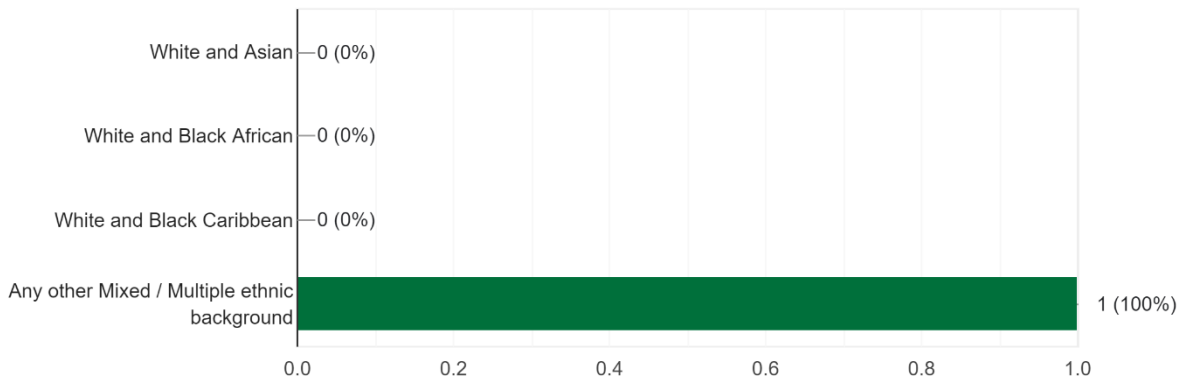

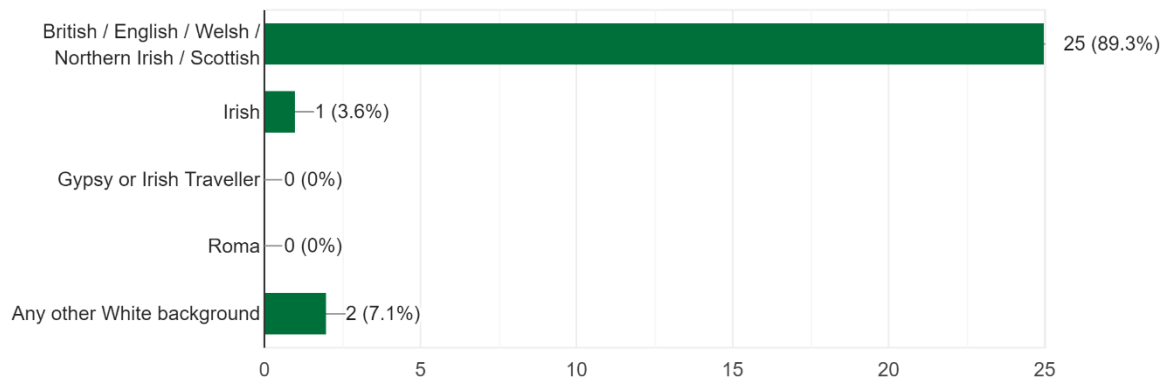

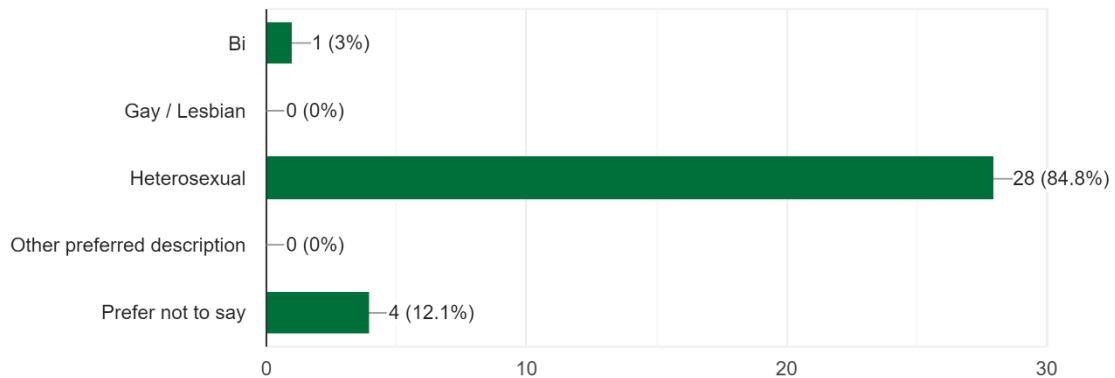
8. What is your religion or belief?

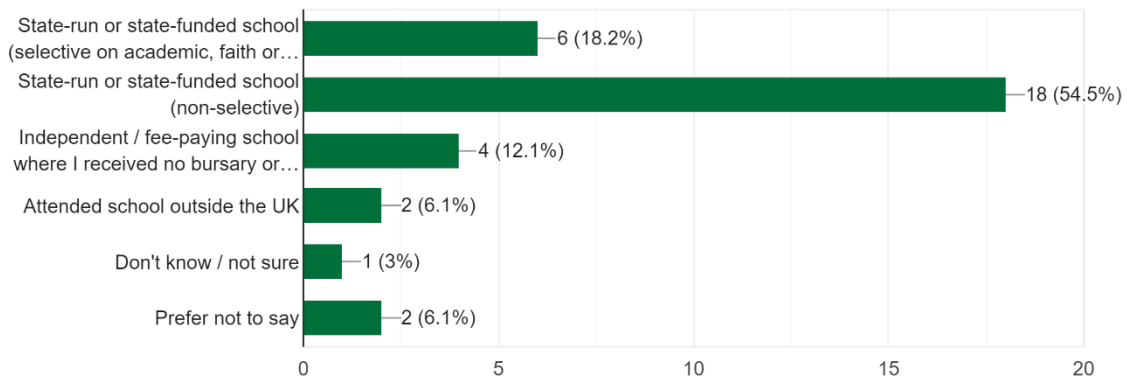
9. What is your sexual orientation?

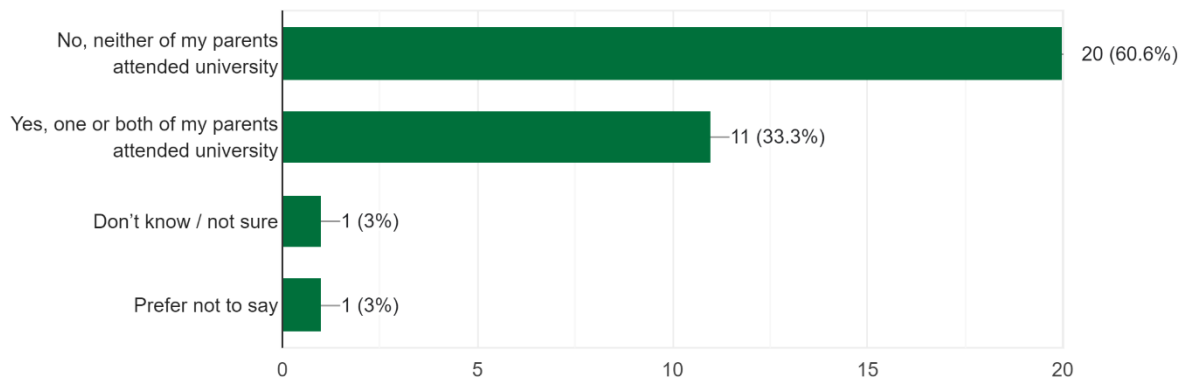
10. Which type of school did you attend for the most time between the ages of 11 and 16? If you changed schools, please base your answer on the last two years of your education.

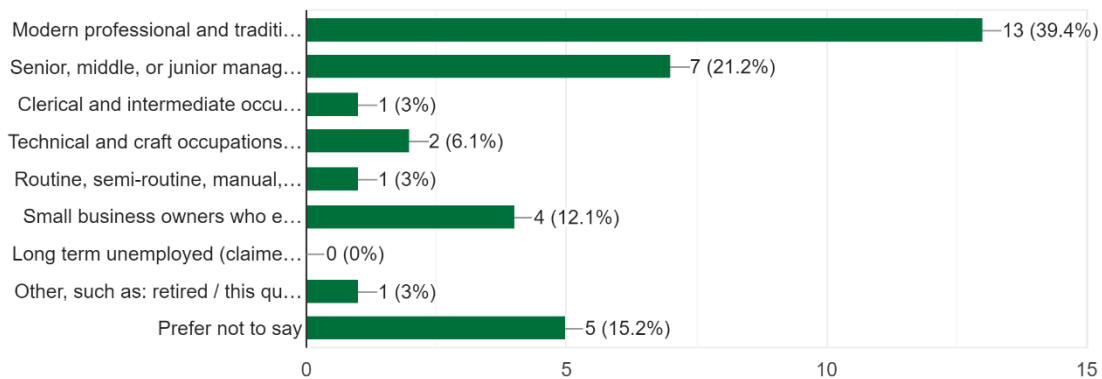

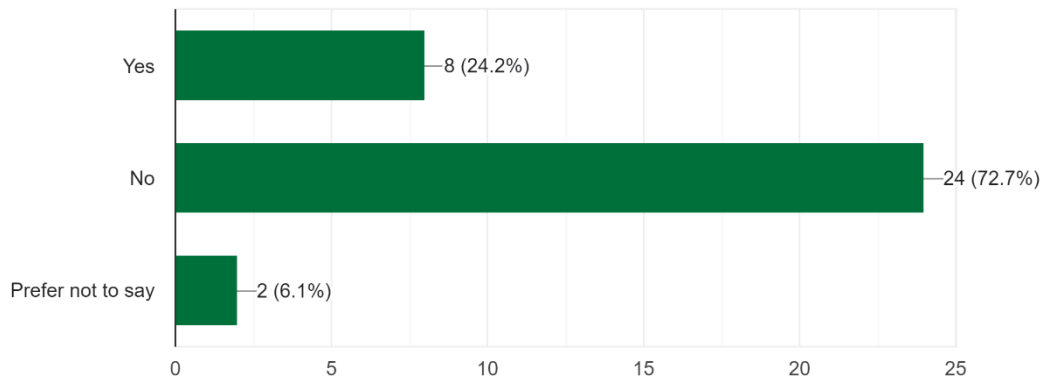
